

Speaker Recognition

The Raise Hand Feature

To be recognized to speak on an item before the body, we will use Zoom's Raise Hand feature, which allows attendees to indicate that they wish to speak or to vote in a show of hands. As with typical Annual Conferences, hands will need to be raised and lowered as speeches for and against are taken.

To Raise Your Hand

To Raise Your Hand, click the gray hand icon at the bottom of your Zoom window. The icon will turn blue, and the bishop will be notified.



To Lower Your Hand

After you have been recognized, or if you no longer need to be recognized, you can lower your hand by clicking the hand icon again. The hand will turn gray.



To Speak

If the bishop recognizes your raised hand, they may choose to allow you to speak. If so, you will receive a prompt to unmute your mic. *Unmute your mic by clicking "confirm"*, and speak.
